FCD MODULES

Helping Skills: Basic career facilitating processes, including productive interpersonal relationships

Labor Market Information: Labor market and occupational information and trends

Assessment: Both formal and informal career development assessments

Diverse Populations: Special needs of various groups, as well as how to adapt services to meet those needs

Ethical & Legal Issues: Studies on the Code of Ethics and current legislative regulations

Technology: The understanding and use of career development computer applications

Career Development Model: Career development theories, models and techniques
